### Decisions:

  - Minutes 5.26.09 revisions – APPROVED
2. ULO's – tweak language
  - Do we need instructions for the language? No, a matrix will be used University Wide to show the holes.
  - On item number 2, we need to separate these out, they are different things.
  - On item number 3, what do we mean here? Civic engagement, community service? How do we assess it?
  - Suggest we take GEC and expand it to create ULO's – breadth, communication, inquiry, critical thinking, further learning. Then we would add integrated learning. Mike will draft some language and share with Darren. It would come back to EPCC, and then out to the faculty.
  - How we roll out the ULO's is as important as the ULO's language. Darren will work on the language explaining the ULO's.

  - Has it been through all the colleges? A&S, specifically A&L is concerned over language on the 5.12.09 faculty senate approved document.
  - Darren will be sending a notice to instructors who don't meet the new GEC requirements to provide notice that they will need to review their course and bring forward to EPCC if they want it to remain Gen Ed. Eventually, all Gen Ed courses will need to be reviewed by EPCC to determine if they meet the new GEC criteria.
